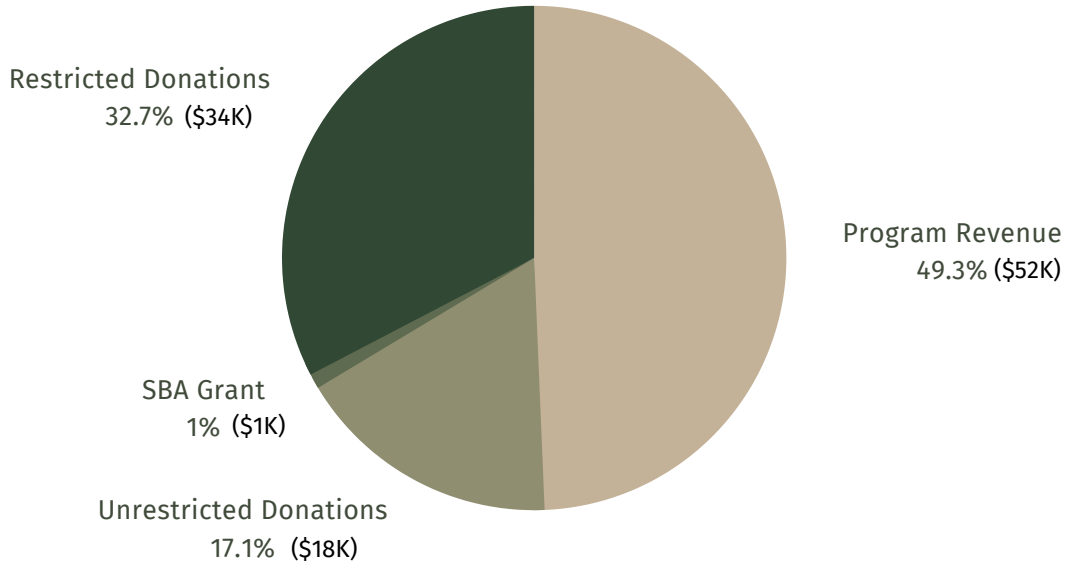

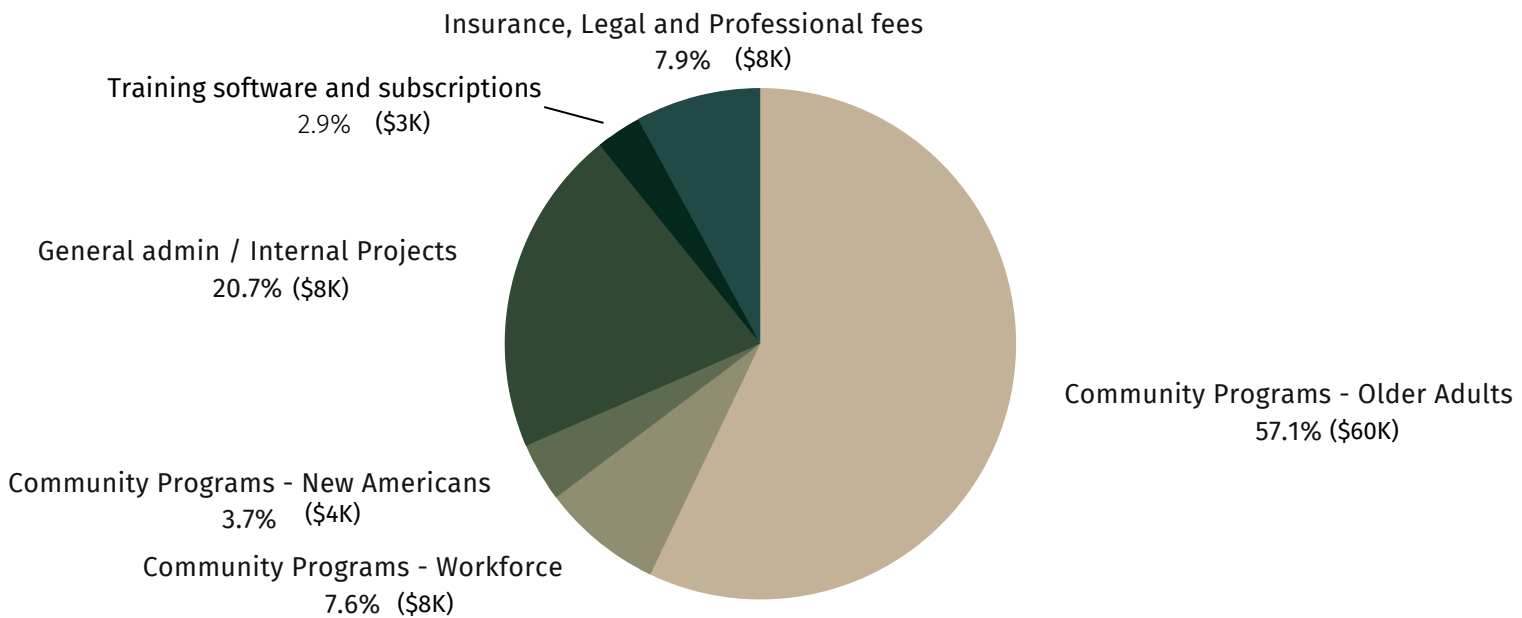
Income
